- The curriculum structures within our College enable us to provide a very diverse range of pathways options to cater to the specific talents of our students in our LEAP program.

LEAP Program at TLSC

Our program had been developed to specifically challenge and support high achieving students by;

- providing opportunities to extend and challenge them in their learning
- exposing them to a broad range of learning and leadership opportunities
- individually tailoring their program from Year
 7 to 12 to maximize their study scores and expand their pathways beyond school
- providing a vibrant learning environment with like minded peers whilst still allowing students the opportunities to participate in all the other aspects of secondary school life.
- Acknowledging that high achievers are not all the same, with each having particular strengths that need to be nurtured and we work closely with students and their families to maximise the potential for talent development.

Eligibility for enrolment in the program

- Twenty-five Year 7 students will be selected for the 2021 Year 7 LEAP Program
- Students must have an offer of enrolment at Taylors Lakes Secondary College for 2021

Who is this program suitable for?

- Students who are motivated learners, needing to be challenged in their learning program
- Students with above average skills in literacy and numeracy, who typically perform at a high level
- Students who are well organised and able to take responsibility for their learning
- Students looking to hone their talents and maximize their academic performance

Application Process

Should you wish to have your child considered for the LEAP program, it is necessary to obtain an enrolment form and further details from the General Office at the College.

Selection Criteria

Selection will be based on:

- Literacy and Numeracy data
 - An Aptitude Test
 - Student Interview
 - Reference checking from primary schools
